All information requested is required for the application to be complete. Do not leave any blank spaces or lines for items that do not apply to you. Use Not Applicable (N/A) where needed. Please list information only for those individuals who are applying to live in the unit. "All household members" refers to applicant/ co-applicant only. If you are completing the preliminary application for someone else, you must attach a valid Power of Attorney for that person.

Preliminary Applications are placed on the waiting list in the order in which they are received completed. The 30047 zip code and those who are Veterans with U.S. Armed Services do qualify for a **preference** established by HUD with this facility. In addition, HUD requires that 40% of units be rented to applicants who meet the "Extremely Low" Income limits (30% of median). In 2023, Extremely Low Income for the Atlanta Metro Area is \$21,500.00 for one person and \$24,550.00 for two persons. The maximum income that qualifies for housing in this community is \$57,200.00 for an individual and \$65,350.00 for two persons. To comply with HUD requirements, selection of applicants on the Waiting List can result in exceptions made to the order received. This process will allow the owner/agent to collect the needed information on all members of the household. Completed documents should be stapled together for each household and placed in the household's file. Parents or guardians are to complete the self-certification for children under the age of 18. Once system development funds are provide and the appropriate system upgrades have been implemented, owners/agents will be required to report the race and ethnicity data electronically to the TRACS (Tenant Rental Assistance Certification System). This information is considered non-sensitive and does no require any special protection.

A. General Instructions:

This form is to be completed by individuals wishing to be served (applicants) and those that are currently served (tenants) in housing assisted by the Department of Housing and Urban Development.

Owner and agents are required to offer the applicant/tenant the option to complete the form. The form is to be completed at initial application or at lease signing. In-place tenants must also be offered the opportunity to complete the form as part of the next interim or annual recertification. Once the form is completed it need not be completed again unless the head of household or household composition changes. There is no penalty for persons who do not complete the form. However, the owner or agent may place a note in the tenant file stating the applicant/tenant refused to complete the form. **Parents or guardians are to complete the form for children under the age of 18.**

The Office of Housing has been given permission to use this form for gathering race and ethnic data in assisted housing programs. Completed documents for the entire household should be stapled together and placed in the household's file.

- **1.** The two ethnic categories you should choose from are defined below. You should check one of the two categories.
 - 1. **Hispanic or Latino.** A person of Cuban, Mexican, Puerto Rican, South or Central American, or other Spanish culture or origin, regardless of race. The term "Spanish origin" can be used in addition to "Hispanic" or "Latino."
 - **2. Not Hispanic or Latino.** A person not of Cuban, Mexican, Puerto Rican, South or Central American, or other Spanish culture or origin, regardless of race.
- **2.** The five racial categories to choose from are defined below: You should check as many as apply to you.
 - 1. American Indian or Alaska Native. A person having origins in any of the original peoples of North and South America (including Central America), and who maintains tribal affiliation or community attachment.
 - **2. Asian.** A person having origins in any of the original peoples of the Far East, Southeast Asia, or the Indian subcontinent including, for example, Cambodia, China, India, Japan, Korea, Malaysia, Pakistan, the Philippine Islands, Thailand, and Vietnam
 - **3. Black or African American.** A person having origins in any of the black racial groups of Africa. Terms such as "Haitian" or "Negro" can be used in addition to "Black" or "African American."
 - **4.** Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander. A person having origins in any of the original peoples of Hawaii, Guam, Samoa, or other Pacific Islands.
 - **5. White.** A person having origins in any of the original peoples of Europe, the Middle East or North Africa.
